In accordance with Regulation No. 2016/679, known as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and amended Act No. 78-17 of 6 January 1978 on data processing, files and freedoms, personal data concerning you have been collected by EDF for the Electrification Europe Summit and are processed by EDF, as controller, to invite you to the various events organised by EDF.

These are the following categories of personal data: civility, identity, e-mail address.

This processing is recorded in EDF's register of processing activities. Your data may be communicated to Auditoire, the agency in charge of organising the event, which acts as a subcontractor of EDF.

The legal basis for the processing is the legitimate interest of EDF (legitimate interest in maintaining relations with its partners and stakeholders).

The data that have been collected by EDF directly from you will be stored in accordance with the time limits indicated to you at the time of collection of the said data; for data transmitted by EDF to Auditoire, the said data will be stored until 31/12/2019.

In accordance with the above-mentioned law, you have the right to access, oppose, rectify and delete data concerning you. You also have a right to limit the processing of your data and the right to transmit post-mortem instructions to EDF.
